3. listened to a report regarding the Joint Rec Board;
4. approved the minutes of the June 15, 2010, regular meeting and the June 30, 2010, special meeting;
5. approved investment and financial reports as presented;
6. accepted the resignation of Cathleen Heidelberg as superintendent;
7. approved the resignation of Adam Kreinbrink as assistant soccer coach;
8. approved the resignation of Benjamin F. Whetstone as assistant football coach;
9. employed Cathleen Heidelberg as a consultant, effective August 1, 2010, at a per diem rate;
10. employed Steve Sutherland as a substitute custodian;
11. employed individuals in supplemental salary positions for the 2010-2011 school year;
12. employed Sharon Kimmel as school nurse for the 2010-2011 school year;
13. approved extended hours for Sandra Leigh, foreign language lab paraprofessional, and Teresa Leinweber, junior/senior high school library paraprofessional;

15. employed Bob Gleason as a custodian, retroactive to July 1, 2010;
